How?

Est. in 1981, SAcommunity is a free online directory of community services funded by the Government of South Australia & Public Library Services.

Our team collect, review, edit & summarise community service information that is traditionally dynamic, fragmented & dispersed across websites & social media.

Providing information for stakeholders including government, councils/libraries, service providers & the public about the services available near them.

What?

SAcommunity is a single, collaboratively editable, public website, a controlled wiki that everyone can contribute to & a single data export source.

Data can be used for referrals, communication, consultation, networking & research to reach out to the community for engagement.

Web analytics, can assist to make informed decisions about services, needs & availability in the local area.

Who are we?

SAcommunity is provided by Connecting Up & delivered by volunteers in conjunction with an expansive stakeholder network.

Conserving & maximising resources required in maintaining the same data/contact details between & within councils & departments



Data exports are by council & filtered via a variety of categories




SAcommunity Services

Stories on organisations, programs or upcoming events, create new connections, assist with service awareness and help services reach new members/supporters & build community capacity.









Lead or Follow – provide/share media releases




